- **1. Meeting Opening & Officer Selection** The meeting began with a discussion on the process of selecting officers. Morris moved that the current President, VP, and Secretary retain their positions. Monica seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.
- **2. Approval of Minutes** There was a discussion on the process for approving and posting meeting minutes. The council agreed that minutes will not be posted until they have been formally approved at a Parish Council meeting.

- Morris requested an amendment include that the coffee cups will be sold as a fundraiser for CCW. Micayla requested an edit to the proper spelling of a council member's name. Morris moved that the minutes be approved as corrected. Bill Mahin seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.
- **3. Pastor's Report** Father provided updates on the Mass schedule, which has reverted to 8:30 AM Sunday morning at St. Edward's, with Munden and Cuba alternating Saturdays at 4:00 PM.

 - o Father Kieffer will be on vacation from September 17-27.
 - Barry Brinkman will lead Mass at St. Isidore on the 27th.
 - Father will be on a pilgrimage to Rome from November 10th-20th and is seeking a replacement for Masses.

4. Old Business

• Mary Statue: The Mary statue was moved from the front of the steps to the front of the garage. The council discussed next steps for repair. There was discussion about whether

- Stairs and Gutters: Micayla is following up with Heath Hoge on a quote for the stairs.
 Winslow came and assessed the gutters where water was entering and pooling in the church basement, and also looked at installing a new window in one of the rooms downstairs.
- Security Updates: The council needs to repair the Exit door with a push bar and update the
 security system and locks for all doors. Ivey Locksmith quoted between \$2,000-\$3,000 per
 door. Micayla and Ed Larson are working on writing a grant to help pay for the doors and will
 follow up on the quote for the doors that were already purchased.

5. New Business

• **Memorial Bench:** Bob Morris reported that the Scott family would like to place a memorial bench on the grounds. There was discussion about the placement of the bench. Bob will gather additional information and report back.

6. Committees

- **Building Committee:** Melissa resigned from the Building Committee and Brent asked to step down as the chairperson.
 - Capital Campaign: The council discussed the status of the new church construction. Members of the building committee reported on their presentation of the renovation to the Bishop. Father Kieffer will speak with the Art and Architecture committee, as well as ESS, and will report back to the council. The council will then determine next steps.
- Finance Committee A motion was made to remove Father Ryan from all St. Edward bank accounts and add Father Joseph Kieffer and Deacon Steve Heiman to the bank signature card. Monica moved and Morris seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.
