

Unofficial Minutes of St. Edward's CCW

June 1, 2026

President Kay Rieke called the June 1, 2026 meeting of St. Edward's CCW to order at 7:00 p.m. in the Sacred Heart Center. Ten members were present.

Minutes of the April 13, 2026 meeting were read and approved. Chris Wilber gave her treasurer's report. Numerous expenses and income were brought forward. Kay then submitted some bills for refreshments and prizes for the Ladies Salad Supper and Deb Krotz, 100th Anniversary Committee Chairperson, presented bills that CCW agreed to pay from the 100th Anniversary Celebration on May 31st. Stephanie Stindt moved that the treasurer's report be accepted and all bills be paid. Karen Splichal seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Under communications, Kay congratulated those responsible in any way for the Ladies Salad Supper and the 100th Anniversary Celebration. Both were successes. A discussion was held on hosting a welcome of some sort in July for our new priest, Father Gnanasekar. Karen then reported on the SDCCW Convention to be held in Salina on August 29. The registration begins July 1. There is a \$30.00 registration fee. Each parish is asked to give a \$35.00 gift or donation.

The Rosary Rally scheduled for Saturday, June 6, at the courthouse in Belleville was mentioned. The hope is that many will attend. Also mentioned was that CCW's card ministry continues. Thank you to Marcia Hansen for sending the cards. Cards being mailed to seminarians by CCW members also continues.

The old business portion of the meeting consisted of a short report on mug sales. The membership also discussed a basket for Lesley Popelka, and a card was signed by those present for Lesley.

New business centered upon the several summer activities scheduled at St. Edward's in which CCW has been asked to assist. First, Prayer in Action will be here the month of June. CCW has been asked to prepare the Sunday evening meals on June 7, 14, and 21 for approximately 50 people each week. Since the St. Edward's sloppy joe recipe has been located, that is to be served each of the three Sunday nights. Kay will send out a sign-up sheet to members for needed food and other items.

On June 18, CCW has been asked to provide three dozen sandwiches to the local blood drive. Carol Levendosky, Elaine Clark, and Chris each volunteered to provide a

dozen sandwiches. The drive will be held from noon until 6 p.m. Diane Heiman, Joyce Waddington, and Chris will serve the sandwiches.

Also under new business, Totus Tuus will be at St. Edward's from July 12-17. Last year, members made meals and snacks for approximately 12 people during the week. Volunteers will be needed and meal ideas. FlockNotes and emails will be sent out by Kay in July.

Kay mentioned that on June 10 at Courtland an outside adoration will be held. The next CCW business meeting will be a July social for coffee and perhaps rosary making. After prayer intentions and the spiritual message from the Magnifica Humanitas, the meeting was adjourned at 7:50 p.m.
