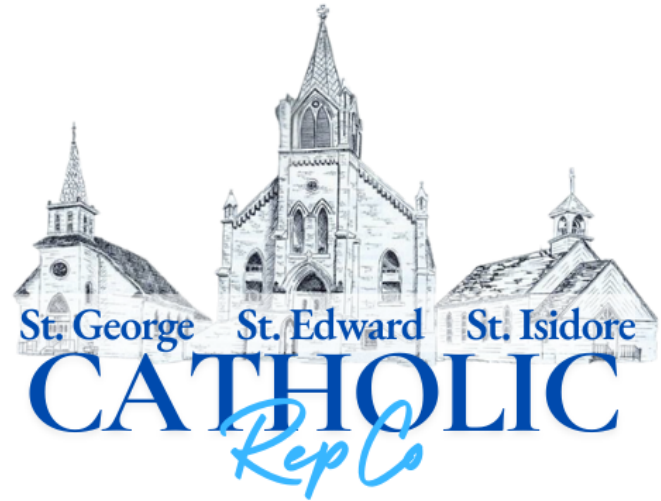

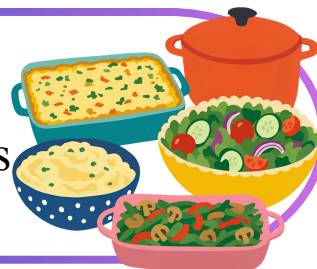

Mercy That Changes Everything

The Church celebrates the Feast of St. Mary Magdalene on July 22 (Wednesday). She reminds us that no one is beyond the reach of God's mercy. Once burdened by suffering, she encountered Jesus, and that single encounter changed the direction of her life forever. She became one of His most faithful disciples, remained with Him at the Cross, and was the first to witness the joy of the Resurrection.

The story of St. Mary Magdalene teaches us that our past does not define us—God's grace does. Jesus does not see us only through our failures; He sees the person we can become through His love. Like Mary Magdalene, we are called to leave behind fear, guilt, and regret, and to embrace the new life that Christ offers.

The risen Lord still calls each of us by name, inviting us into a deeper relationship with Him. His mercy is never exhausted, and His love has the power to heal every wounded heart and transform every life.

As we celebrate the feast of St. Mary Magdalene, let us open our hearts to God's mercy. May our encounter with Christ renew us, strengthen our faith, and inspire us to become joyful witnesses of His love in our families, our parish, and our community.

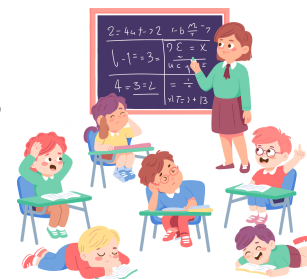
