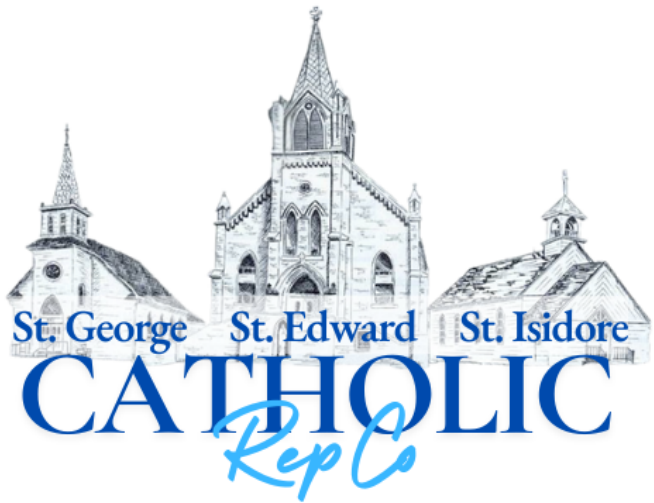

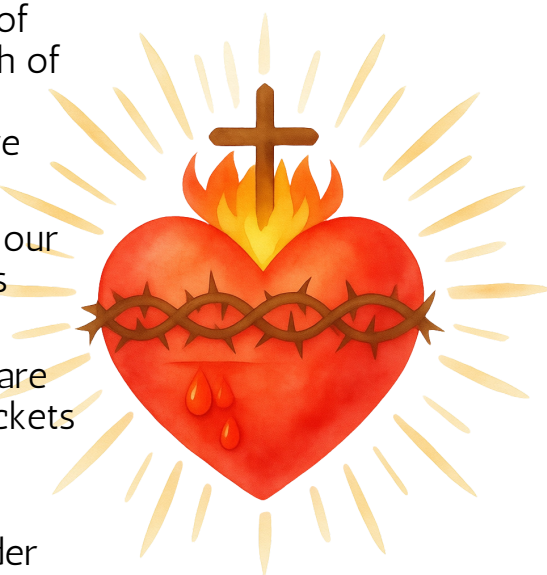
Sacred Heart of Jesus, have mercy on us
