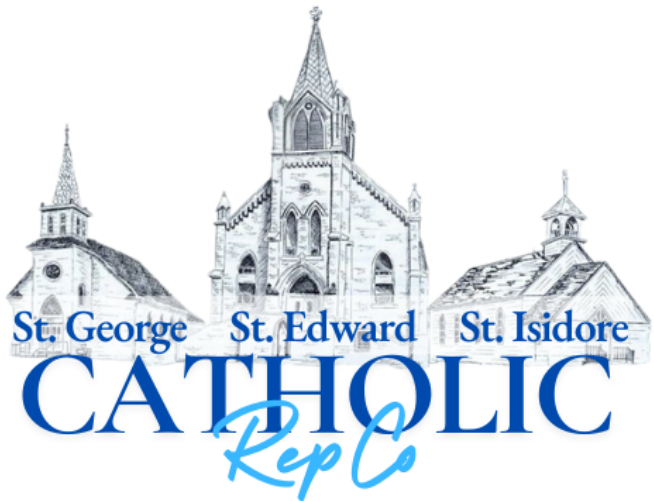

FOOD FOR THOUGHT

The Black Dot

One day, a professor entered the classroom and asked his students to prepare for a surprise test. They all waited anxiously at their desks for the exam to begin. The professor handed out the exams with the text facing down, as usual. Once he handed them all out, he asked the students to turn over the papers. To everyone's surprise, there were no questions – just a black dot in the center of the sheet of paper.

The professor, seeing the expression on everyone's faces, told them the following: "I want you to write about what you see there." The students, confused, got started on the inexplicable task. At the end of the class, the professor took all the exams, and started reading each one of them out loud, in front of all the students. All of them, with no exception, defined the black dot, trying to explain its position in the center of the sheet.

After all had been read, the classroom silent, the professor started to explain: "I'm not going to grade you on this, I just wanted to give you something to think about. No one wrote about the white part of the paper. Everyone focused on the black dot and the same happens in our lives. We have white paper to hold onto and enjoy, but we are so busy contemplating the dark spots that's in there. Life is a special gift, and we will always have reasons to celebrate. It is changing and renewing everyday- our friends, jobs, livelihood, love, family, the miracles we see every day." And yet we insist on focusing only on the dark spots – the health issues that are bothering us, the money that we need to have, the luxuries we don't have, complications in any relationship, problems with a family member, the disappointment with a friend and so on.

We need to realize that the dark spots are very small and only few. And yet we allow these to pollute our minds.

Let us take our eyes away from the black spots and enjoy each blessing, each moment that life gives us!
