April 28, 2025

The Parish Councils of St. Edward, Belleville; St. George, Munden; and St. Isidore, Cuba met Monday April 28, 2025, at 7:00pm in the basement of St. Edward Catholic Church. Fr. Ryan McCandless, Keely Meinecke, Micayla Walden; St. Edward Council: Mike Baxa, Bob Morris, Stephanie Stindt, Morris Wilber; St. Isidore Council: Wayne Pachta; and St. George Council: Jim and Ronda Blecha and Paul Chopp were all present.

Fr. Ryan led the opening prayer by leading the Memorare.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and accepted.

The Pastor's report included information about the Easter Triduum being an awesome spiritual experience. First Communion on April 27th, enabled seven children to participate more fully in the celebration of the Most Holy Eucharist. Server training is set for May 4th after Mass. Ministry Training will be June 29th after Mass. June 22nd will be Corpus Christi procession with a potluck dinner to follow.

The maintenance report addressed the issues of the SHC outlets and kitchen furnace bid requests. The Mary statue in the front façade is waiting for the contractor.

Old Business- Kay has developed a crisis plan and needs some additions and will be printed. Anne is working on a stewardship plan that also needs additions and printed. Parish signage was discussed but no formal action of the council was taken. Directory for the cemeteries was a topic for discussion by the council.

New Business- Parish Council nominations to fill two spots were discussed. Fall Festival date is set for October 12. Chairperson is yet to be determined. Mass times may adjust in July. Faith Formation, parish offices and SHC entrance door were up for discussion under new business. The Building Committee has released a FAQ and a trip to Virginia Tile near Kansas City is being planned.

St. Isidore – Wayne will take care of the driveway rock and ask cemetery board to share cost of mowing.

St. George has a plumber to repair plumbing issues at the church this week.

The closing prayer was led by Fr. Ryan inviting everyone to pray the Lord's prayer.
