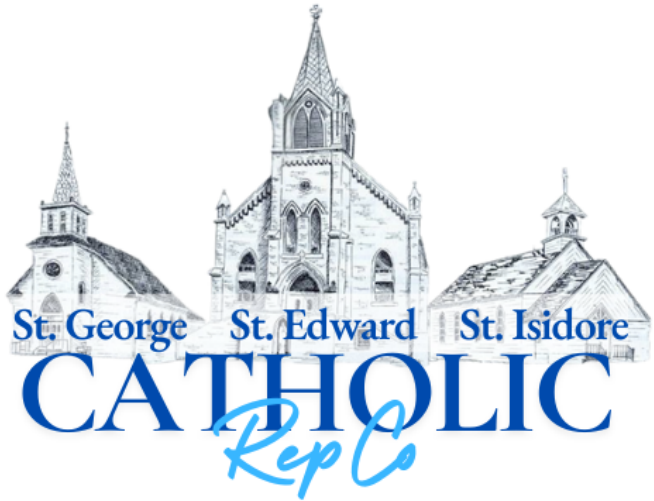

May the Lord bless you and your families, and may the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary and our patron saints guide us in all that we do.

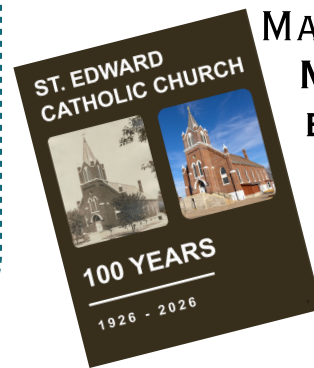
