

PASTOR'S CORNER

Divine Mercy Sunday was officially designated as the Second Sunday of Easter during the canonization process of St. Faustina Kowalska by St. John Paul II in April of 2000. Twenty five years later we celebrate this day usually in tandem with those youth who will be receiving their First Communion. What a tremendous day for the Church to grow in her participants being more fully drawn into the mystery of the Body of Christ. Today, we are called to look upon the image of Jesus, who so lightly lifts his robe to shine out from it the blue and red rays emitting from his heart. These rays demonstrate the Baptismal and Eucharistic reality of Jesus' presence in the Church's Sacraments. Today, these youth will receive the undying Lord within themselves so to live a life united to God and in imitation of Jesus. We pray for them, as they are now in a fuller way communing with us, and offering their gifts upon the altar of God. What great joy it is that they now are bound up in this mystery of God in this intimate way.
